## **Biographical Sketch**

John Melnick was born on November 10, 1928 to parents Arseny and Rose (Patek) Melnick. He had two brothers and two sisters. He attended the Youngstown Public Schools, graduating from Rayen High School in 1946. He was a 1949 graduate of Youngstown College (now Youngstown State University) with a degree in Pre-Med. He continued at Youngstown College in the School of Education and earned a teaching certificate for high school physics, math, chemistry, and biology in 1950.

His medical education continued as an American Heart Association research fellow in biochemistry at Case Western Reserve University (CWRU). He earned his Doctor of Medicine degree in 1955 from CWRU and served a two-year internship at the Youngstown Hospital Association. He then went to Fort Lawton Hospital in Seattle Washington, where he was the Chief of Radiology for two years in the U.S. Army Medical Corps.

He came back to Youngstown in 1959 for a three-year residency in Radiology at the South Unit of the Youngstown Hospital Association. Dr. Melnick then completed a one-year Fellowship in Radiology at the University of Cincinnati.

For a short time he was a radiologist with Dr. David Berens and Associates in Buffalo, New York before he was hired as a staff radiologist at the Youngstown Hospital Association South Unit in 1963. He served as the Vice Chief of Diagnostic Imaging, Director of the Department of Nuclear Medicine, and finally the Director of Radiology before he retired in 1996. He was also President of the professional corporation Associates in Radiology, which provided radiological services at South Unit.

Dr. Melnick wrote eight research articles that were published in medical journals. His discovery and paper on a rare bone disorder in 1965 was significant. The disorder is now called Melnick-Needles Syndrome. He published another paper discussing the syndrome in 1982.

His interest in medical history led him to write several articles on local medical history during the Mahoning County Medical Society's centennial celebration in 1972. These articles led to his self-published book *A History of Medicine in Youngstown and the Mahoning Valley*. He was a member of the Board of Directors of the Mahoning Valley Historical Society and a member of the Western Reserve Historical Society. In 1974, he was elected President of the Medical Society. In 1981, he was named Doctor of the Year following his discovery of the link between the incidence of cancer and irradiation of the thymus gland.

Dr. Melnick dreamed of opening a museum that would cultivate an interest in medical history in the Mahoning Valley. The Rose Melnick Medical Museum took shape in the 1990s and finally opened on the campus of Youngstown State University in 2000.

The other great interest in Dr. Melnick's life was Mill Creek Park. He wrote a book about the history of the park, called *The Green Cathedral*, which was published in 1976. He was active on the Citizen's Committee. He established the John C. Melnick, M.D. Mill Creek Park Museum at Fellows Riverside Gardens and funded the observation tower there, which he named in honor of his father.

He had four children: Jacquelyn, John, Michael, and Gregory.

Dr. Melnick died on January 15, 2008 after an extended illness.

#### **Scope and Content**

These papers are in artificial order and came to the archives without formal documentation. The materials were gathered from the creator's office, which had been unused for 5 years after his death. There was little organization to the papers in his desk and on shelves. Dr. Melnick's papers were mixed with papers from others, which he might have been collecting for his own interest, for the museum, and/or to document local medical history. These papers were separated when possible.

Most of the papers date from the 1960s and 1970s. A collection of papers from an early Youngstown physician, Dr. Henry Manning, pushed the time period of this collection to the 1830s.

The processor created the series arrangement of the collection to facilitate its use. Attempts were made to maintain original folder headings and contents. The majority of Dr. Melnick's papers cover his professional work as a radiologist and supervisor of radiology interns at Youngstown Hospital Association South Unit, as well his own private practice in radiology. The collection also includes examples of his professional writing, like copies of his published papers, drafts, and his research notes. The collection also includes his notes and research materials for his book, *A History of Medicine in Youngstown and the Mahoning Valley*. In 2020, a 0.25-foot box of calibration reports for radiology machines at YHA was donated by Chuck Wissuchek. Dr. Melnick had given these papers to Mr. Wissuchek for safe keeping when they worked together in the 1980s. Mr. Wissuchek kept the papers when he retired in 2005.

Items weeded from the collection consisted of duplicates, small personal notes, and outdated medical education materials like a collection of slide carrousels and VHS tapes.

#### **SERIES I: Youngstown Hospital Association**

Dr. Melnick worked as a radiologist at the Youngstown Hospital Association from 1963 until his retirement in 1996. This series contains information about the hospital, but more specifically the activities of the radiology department. There were many binders in this series. The contents were put in folders and labeled using the title on the binder. This series begins with information on the hospital in general, with information specific to the radiology department following. The radiology department records are annual reports, correspondence, and information on the residency program, procedure manuals, image record books, fee schedules, and information about the department's equipment. Within these topics, folders are arranged in a roughly chronological order.

This series contains reprints of those articles, as well as drafts, related articles, notes, correspondence, and data. The folders in this series are arranged in chronological order of the published article. Original folder titles were maintained when possible. Some of the files in this series have been restricted because they contain Personal Health Information (PHI) about patients in Dr. Melnick's studies on breast cancer, thyroid cancer, and Melnick Needles Syndrome. ## **Series V: History of medicine research**

This series contains information that Dr. Melnick collected to document the history of medicine in the Mahoning Valley in the early 1970s. He used this information to write several articles for the Bulletin of the Mahoning County Medical Society and later collected these articles into a book, *A History of Medicine in Youngstown and the Mahoning Valley, Ohio*. There are announcement cards of physicians opening offices, pages from local doctors' prescription pads, and publications that cover the history of Youngstown Hospital Association, St. Elizabeth's Hospital, and the Mahoning Valley Medical Society. The processor collected the clippings of obituaries and news articles about local doctors found throughout the papers into alphabetical files, since there was evidence that Dr. Melnick kept alphabetical files of those materials. A few doctors have their own folders due to the amount of information about them. Among these, there are also several folders of papers attributed to Henry Manning, an early doctor in Youngstown who was also involved with a drug store and Mahoning County Bank. These papers, dated 1830 to 1860, were found grouped in several folders. The processor has arranged them into new folders by the type of document.
