Minutes of Meeting of March 9, 1971

1. The minutes of the Council meeting of February 22, 1971, were corrected as follows:

Delete the last sentence of the next to last paragraph on page one, and replace it with the sentence:

"It was generally agreed that the Senate approved requirements concerning mathematics and science be observed."

- 2. Dr. Foster reminded Council that the proposed <u>Assignments of Students</u> to Schools by Majors is not complete.
- 3. Council discussed the first 13 points of President Pugsley's proposed guidelines governing promotions and related problems. Regarding point 1, there was a general feeling that 5 years is a little too long for a minimum. It was suggested that either 3 or 4 years be stated as the minimum, emphasizing that promotion could normally not be expected after the minimum period except in very exceptional cases. It was recommended that point 6 be moved up into position immediately after point 1. Regarding point 4, there was a general feeling that the range of salary brackets should be broadened.
- Council agreed to meet with the Academic Affairs Committee at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, March 12, 1971 in the Conference Room of the Arts and Sciences Building to discuss Early Grades for Graduating Students.
- 5. Dean Charignon raised the question of the status of Senior Sheets: (Add to agenda).
- 6. Dean Miller requested that his suggestion concerning scheduling hours be put on the agenda.
- 7. Dean Robinson requested that a discussion on an "early admissions policy" be added to the agenda.
