ACADEMIC AFFAIRS

(1) The minutes of the May 16 meeting were approved after Item 7 had been corrected by the Academic Vice President. As corrected Item 7 reads as follows:

The question of summer class size for courses taught by chairmen was discussed but no change in policy was made. Therefore, the same procedures apply for the approval of small classes whether taught by chairmen or faculty.

(2) Dr. George Letchworth, a guest at the meeting, discussed the need for coordination of University-wide counseling and guidance activities. He indicated his willingness to be of assistance to all persons throughout the University involved in counseling-type activities. To facilitate this assistance, he suggested a meeting between him and persons designated by the Deans of the several Schools and Colleges for the purpose of discussing ways to improve counseling activities and articulation between his office and the Schools.

Some Deans saw value in his suggestion and volunteered to have representatives of their Schools meet with Dr. Letchworth. Subsequently, it was decided that each School would recommend a person or two to meet with Dr. Letchworth to explore the issue further.

(3) The President then joined the Council for an extended discussion of various personnel and budgetary issues.
