

ACADEMIC DEANS COUNCIL

Minutes of November 14, 1972

Present: Vice President Edgar, Deans Aurand, Charignon, Krill, Miller, Paraska, Scriven, Vanaman, and Yozwiak.

Meeting was called to order at 1305.

1. Minutes of November 9 were approved as distributed.
 2. Dr. Edgar pointed out that next Tuesday, November 21, there will be the annual gathering of Guidance Counsellors from the various high schools to which a number of the deans are being invited. Due to this conflict, there will be no meeting next week.
 3. Dr. Edgar distributed the report on UCES meeting. He pointed out that members of the UCES committee will discuss this report with their respective chairmen with the idea of encouraging students to utilize as a minor Environmental Studies.
 4. Dean Krill distributed a report from the Ad Hoc Committee that was studying the summer quarter offering. Dean Charignon pointed out the problem with the Engineering School. Dean Yozwiak raised the question of the basis on effecting savings and asked the question, "Why is it necessary to economize in the summer school?" And further, he asked how the indicated \$25,000 saving would be effected. Dean Krill pointed out that this would be a proportionate application to the various schools and colleges. Dean Aurand raised a very valid question about the applied music cost and in particular, pointed out that no recognition was given to the extra fee paid by students taking applied music. The discussion then turned to the suggested steps to be taken for summer quarter subsequent to the 1973 summer quarter. The discussion and decision pertaining to summer quarter offering was deferred to the next meeting.
 5. Dean Scriven distributed Final Exam Schedule for the spring quarter '73. Action will be taken at the next meeting. Dean Scriven also distributed a form requesting advisory transcripts. The cost of duplicating this form and the advisory transcripts will continue to be borne by the Registrar's Office.
 6. Dean Paraska raised a question about when retrenchment will be discussed. Dr. Edgar indicated that this would be done in the very near future.
 7. The meeting adjourned at 1440.
