

MINUTES OF ACADEMIC DEANS COUNCIL

March 6, 1973

Present: Vice-President E. Edgar, Deans: N. Paraska, K. Krill, C. Vanaman, C. Aurand, R. Miller, B. Yozwiak, J. Scriven and M.J. Charignon

1. The meeting was called to order by Vice-President E. Edgar at 1310.
2. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as written.
3. Final copies of the approved calendar and chronological calendar were distributed by Vice-President E. Edgar.
4. The February 19, 1973 minutes of the Ohio Board of Regents were distributed.
5. Dean R. Miller moved the approval of the fall 1973 exam schedule. Seconded by Dean C. Aurand. Motion carried.
6. In order to qualify as making satisfactory progress toward his degree, Dean K. Krill moved that, "Foreign graduate students must be enrolled in a minimum of two courses and must complete the work satisfactorily within that quarter". Seconded by Dean J. Scriven. Motion carried.
7. Vice-President E. Edgar asked all Deans to review the reasons given for I grades in his school and to go over the permitted reasons for I grades with the staff.
8. Dean J. Scriven is to supply each school with the I grades issued by the school in the fall of 1972.
9. A recommendation is to be sent to the Physical Plant Department that push buttons be used to replace keys on all passenger elevators in order to facilitate service to the handicapped.
10. The question of the curriculum committee's consideration of the faculty members to teach a proposed new course was discussed.
11. The progress of the OEA negotiations was discussed.
