

MINUTES OF THE ACADEMIC DEANS COUNCIL

February 12, 1974

Present: Vice-President E. Edgar, Deans J. Scriven, L. Rand, N. Paraska (represented by D. Hille), R. Miller, B. Yozwiak, D. Byo, A. Moore and M.J. Charignon

Guest: Dr. W. Swan

1. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as written.
2. The 1975 academic calendar was approved.
3. It was again announced that any requirements for office space in conjunction with a research project must be indicated in the project proposal at the time it is submitted.
4. Dean J. Scriven reported that no mechanical problems would prevent concurrent registration for summer and fall.
5. Dean J. Scriven was requested to investigate any mechanical problem which might prevent registration for fall or summer or both fall and summer simultaneously.
6. Dean A. Moore moved that the advisor's signature be eliminated on all registrations up to and including 17 quarter hours, as well as on add-drop cards provided that the student had completed at least 36 quarter hours and that a statement relegating the responsibility of proper course choices to the student. Seconded by Charignon and Miller. The motion failed.
7. Dean A. Moore, seconded by Dean R. Miller, made a motion to change procedure so that students register alphabetically on a rotational basis regardless of their completed quarter hours. Action was deferred to a subsequent meeting.
8. Dean J. Scriven moved that the Academic Deans submit evidence to the Academic Vice-President that fall 1974 schedules take into consideration the mature adult student prior to submitting the schedules to the registrar's office; seconded by R. Miller. The motion was tabled.
