MINUTES	Minutes of February 11, 1976 meeting approved.
DEADLINE	E. Edgar reminded the Deans that the copy for the 1976-77 <u>Catalog</u> and the 76-77 budget were due.
APPLICABLE CATALOG	A proposed substitute paragraph of p. 36 of 1975-76 <u>Catalog</u> was redistributed and discussed. The following statement was adopted: Each student entering Youngstown State University is entitled to a copy of the University catalog.
	This catalog or any single subsequent catalog shall be the guide to graduation requirements for the student provided the student is in continuous attendance and does not change majors. When a stu- dent changes majors the catalog in effect at the time of change or any single subsequent catalog shall be the guide to graduation requirements. Readmitted students shall use the catalog in effect upon their last readmission or any subsequent catalog as the guide to graduation requirements. Any exceptions to re- quirements must be approved by the student's department chairman and/or the dean of the school from which he expects to graduate. The University reserves the right to change course offerings and academic requirements. Certain general requirements apply to all degrees earned at Youngstown State while other requirements are spe- cific to the degrees earned. There follows a condensed table of courses required for graduation including those high school or other preparatory units required.
MAJOR MINOR	A proposed re-statement of information on p. 39 or current <u>Catalog</u> on Majors and Minors was distributed. Discussion involved suggested revisions in proposed statement as well as whether or not changes proposed would necessitate action by the Academic Senate. Several motions were made and defeated or removed from consideration. What eventually passed was a motion that the statement with editorial changes was approved and referred to V.P. Edgar for disposition.
REIEVANCE PROCEDURE	A revised draft of "Student Academic Grievance Procedures" submitted to the Deans by the Academic Senate Student Affairs Committee. This will be discussed at the next Deans Council meeting.

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L. Rand reviewed the upcoming North Central accreditation visit. Although the visit will focus on graduate programs the entire academic community will be directly involved.
