Tuesday, November 23, 1976

MEMBERS PRESENT: D'Isa (for Sutton), Alderman, Edgar, McBriarty, McGraw, Moore, Paraska, Rand, Scriven, and Yozwiak.

1. Minutes of the previous meeting were modified to add to Section 2-C the words "in the Library."
2. The deans were reminded to submit comments about the draft copies of the calendar which were previously distributed. Considerable discussion followed, resulting in the following motion:

Moved by Yozwiak and seconded by Moore that the present policy pertaining to a cut-off date for admission remain unchanged.

The vote on the motion resulted in three aye's and three no's. Dr. Edgar indicated that he would take cognizance of the discussion and the results of the voting on the motion.

3. Dr. Letchworth and Mrs. Foley provided additional information as to the efforts and concerns of the Ad Hoc Committee to Study Academic Advisement. Questions and comments on the Committee report were elicited from those in attendance. Subsequently, the following motion was offered:

The Deans Council advise the Executive Committee of the Senate through the administrative representative of specifics in the proposal that are unacceptable.

After considerable discussion, it was moved by Paraska and seconded by Moore that the previous motion be tabled. Motion carried.

Each of the deans was asked to provide individual reactions on the report of this Committee not later than December 3.
