Academic Dean's Council
June 26, 1979

1. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as distributed.
2. Deans should expect to receive, as the summer progresses, various documents related to the Long Range Academic Planning process. Their advice is encouraged after the material is received and read.
3. Scriven reported that enrollment for Summer is 5332 headcount, 2867 FTE, which is about equivalent to last year.
4. Cohen-to-Edgar memo of 6-22-79 (Appendix I) was distributed. Cohen discussed the special admission and registration matters and then responded to questions. Among other questions raised by the deans, Scriven expressed a number of concerns that could result from our departing from the regular process.

It was noted that CES category is similar to the "special" category used at other institutions.

For the re-entry students, it was suggested that an application similar to that used by the Graduate School for workshop-restricted admission might be employed.

Rand moved for approval of Cohen's proposal (3 a & b) for the Weekend Program and this was seconded by Seibold. Scriven moved to amend by striking 3b. Amendment died for lack of a second. Scriven moved to amend by striking in 3b "one quarter only" and replacing it with "a maximum of six courses". Yozwiak seconded amendment. Amendment passed. Motion, as amended, passed.
