Candidate for the Honorary Degree Doctor of Medical Arts

DR. JOHN NORMAN McCANN, Youngstown family physician and community leader, served Youngstown State University as the first chairman of the board of trustees in 1967-68. His retirement from the board in 1972 marked an end to many years as a trustee of the institution, active service which began with his appointment to the board of Youngstown College in 1948. He continues to serve on the board of trustees of the Youngstown Educational Foundation. A lifelong Youngstown resident, Dr. McCann has provided outstanding leadership in civic activities, serving on the executive boards of the YMCA, the Mahoning County Tuberculosis Sanatorium, the Youngstown Foundation, the John D. Finnegan Foundation, and the Community Corporation. He has also been active in medical affairs as member and president of the Ohio Board of Medical Examiners, president of the Federation of State Medical Boards, president of the Mahoning County Medical Society, delegate to the State of Ohio Medical Society, and director of medicine of St. Elizabeth Hospital. Dr. McCann holds B.S. and M.D. degrees from Georgetown University.

The Commencement Speaker

DR. EMILY LIPPINCOTT WICK is dean of the faculty and professor of chemistry at Mount Holyoke College (Massachusetts), a post she has held since 1973. A native of Youngstown, Dr. Wick received bachelor of arts and master of arts degrees from Mount Holyoke. She holds a Ph.D degree in organic chemistry from Massachusetts Institute of Technology where she served on the faculty for 18 years. At MIT Dr. Wick attained the rank of professor of food chemistry, and also served as associate dean of student affairs, with women students her primary responsibility. Dr. Wick was the first woman on the faculty at MIT to receive tenure and the first to be promoted through the faculty ranks to full professor. In 1972 Mount Holyoke awarded her the doctor of science degree, citing her for "first-rate teaching and research . . . and skilled championship of women at MIT." Dr. Wick's research in food chemistry, which has centered on the trace components of food and their biological effects, has been widely published in professional journals. She has served the American Chemical Society in several leadership capacities, and has been honored as a scientific lecturer.

ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities—Bologna, Paris, Oxford—the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. For instance, the lining of the hood placed today over the head of the recipient of the honorary degree is cardinal and white, the colors of Youngstown State University. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters, or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education. It is possible, also, to determine from the length of the hoods the type of degree held by the wearer—quite long for the doctor's degree, medium for the master's, short for the bachelor's.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of

American colleges and universities, too, may wear regalia which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. At Youngstown State University, the candidates for degrees lead the line of march followed by the marshals and the faculty. Then follow the trustees, the president, the speaker and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. The procession at the end of the ceremony follows the reverse order.

Recipients of **University Honors** will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
