### The Commencement Speaker

#### THE HONORABLE HARRY MESHEL

Ohio State Senator Harry Meshel (D-33), an alumnus of Youngstown State and a former faculty member, was elected to the Ohio Senate in 1970.

A native of Youngstown and a graduate of East High School, Senator Meshel received a bachelor of science in business administration degree with honors from YSU, and a master of science degree in urban land economics from the Columbia University Graduate School of Business. He has also completed advanced study in management science at the University of Wisconsin.

During his seven years in the Senate, he has held several important legislative posts including chairman of the Senate Finance Committee, chairman of the sixmember House-Senate Conference Committee on the budget "language" bill, majority whip, chairman of the Legislative Budget Office Committee, and state chairman of the Subcommittee on Architectural Barriers.

Senator Meshel has also served as a member of the Rules Committee, Energy and Public Utilities Committee, Controlling Board, Emergency Board, Legislative Office Building Authority, Legislative Service Commission and the Land Use Review Committee. He also has held the vicechairmanship of the State Employee Compensation Board and is a member of the Council of State Governments.

Prior to his election as state senator, he served as executive assistant to Youngstown Mayor Anthony B. Flask, and as Urban Renewal Director for the City.

Last year Senator Meshel was one of the first five recipients of the Phillips Medal for Public Service given by Ohio University. Among his numerous public service awards are the Meritorious Service Award from the President's Committee on Employment of the Handicapped, Eastern Orthodox Man of the Year, Pulley Award for outstanding citizenship from the Ohio State Association of Elks, the Ohio Disabled Veterans Distinguished Service Award, and the Outstanding Legislator Award from the Ohio Academy of Trial Lawyers.

He is a member of the Board of Trustees of the Eastern Ohio Heart Association, Red Cross, Youngstown Symphony and the North Side Community Action Committee, plus other community service and civic organizations.

#### ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities—Bologna, Paris, Oxford—the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern day descendents. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters, or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education. It is possible, also, to determine from the length of the hoods the type of degree held by the wearer—quite long for the doctor's degree, medium for the master's, short for the bachelor's.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of

American colleges and universities, too, may wear regalia which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. At Youngstown State University, the candidates for degrees lead the line of march followed by the marshals and the faculty. Then follow the trustees, the president, the speaker and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. The procession at the end of the ceremony follows the reverse order.

Recipients of **University Honors** will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
