The Commencement Speaker and Honorary Degree Candidate

THE HONORABLE WILLIAM B. SAXBE

A native of Ohio, the Honorable William B. Saxbe has had a distinguished political career, serving both his state and his country.

First elected to the Ohio House of Representatives in 1947, Mr. Saxbe served as majority leader from 1951-52, and as Speaker of the House from 1953-54. He was elected Attorney General of the State of Ohio in 1956, serving in that position from 1957-58 and 1963-68, a total of eight years, longer than any other Attorney General in Ohio history.

In 1968, Mr. Saxbe was elected to the United States Senate from Ohio, serving until 1974. While a U.S. Senator, Mr. Saxbe was on the Armed Services Committee, Government Operations Committee, Post Office and Civil Service Committee, and the Special Committee on Aging.

January 4, 1974, Mr. Saxbe was appointed Attorney General of the United States by President Richard Nixon, a post he held until February 3, 1975, when he was sworn in as Ambassador to India. He retired as Ambassador in January of 1977, returning to his home town of Mechanicsburg and the practice of law with the firm of Chester, Saxbe, Hoffman & Wilcox.

Mr. Saxbe earned his Bachelor of Arts degree from Ohio State University in 1940, and his Bachelor of Laws degree from Ohio State in 1948. The delay between the two degrees was due to his service in the U.S. Army as a bomber pilot from 1940 to 1945. He also was called to serve during the Korean Conflict and currently holds the rank of full Colonel in the Ohio National Guard.

Mr. Saxbe is a member of the Board of Directors of the Mohawk Rubber Company of Hudson; First Banc Group of Ohio; Acceleration Corporation; and Big Drum Corporation; all of Ohio.

ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities—Bologna, Paris, Oxford—the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters, or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education. It is possible, also, to determine from the length of the hoods the type of degree held by the wearer—quite long for the doctor's degree, medium for the master's, short for the bachelor's.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of American colleges and universities, too, may wear regalia

which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The procession at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of **University Honors** will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
