# The Commencement Speaker

#### **ANN ISROFF**

Ann Isroff is a member of the Youngstown State University Board of Trustees. And, she is very active in Youngstown's service, philanthropic and religious communities.

Mrs. Isroff served the City of Youngstown, under two mayors, as a member of the Human Relations Commission. Her participation in religious organizations and activities include being a member of the National Urban Affairs Commission of the Council of Jewish Federations and Welfare Boards and as a trustee of the Women's Division of Jewish Federation Youngstown. She also served as vicechairman of the Jewish Community Relations Council, and was named "Woman of the Year in Human Relations" by the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith.

Her leadership and service roles in the Youngstown community seem never to be exhausted, for in addition to the notable accomplishments already identified, Ann Isroff established the training program for Youngstown's Rumor Control Center, served on the Board of Trustees for the Urban League, is a member of the St. Elizabeth Hospital Medical Center Board of Trustees, is a member of the Executive Board of the Health Systems Agency and she is a trustee of the Youngstown Area Kidney Foundation.

This is the last year of Mrs. Isroff's nine-year term on the YSU Board of Trustees. Those nine active years included two years as Chairman of the Board. In addition, she served as chairman of the Personnel Relations, Student Affairs and Budget and Finance committees. She also chaired the Ad Hoc committee on Insurance and University Audit and is a Board representative to the YSU Schermer Trust program.

Mrs. Isroff, the former Ann Leshner, is a native of Bradford, Pennsylvania. She is a 1950 graduate of Northwestern University and has taken graduate courses at Youngstown State University. Immediately following graduation from Northwestern University, she accepted a position as Associate Director of Films, Radio and Television with Fuller and Smith and Ross, Inc., a Cleveland advertising agency. Later, she joined Jessup Advertising, in Akron.

After her marriage to Dr. Leonard Isroff, she worked as a freelance copywriter in the Warren Youngstown area. The Isroff's have a son, Michael and a daughter, Judy.

YSU Trustee, Ann Isroff is a lifetime member of the Youngstown State University Alumni Association.

# ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities—Bologna, Paris, Oxford—the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters, or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education. It is possible, also, to determine from the length of the hoods the type of degree held by the wearer—quite long for the doctor's degree, medium for the master's, short for the bachelor's.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of American colleges and universities, too, may wear regalia

which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The procession at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of **University Honors** will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
