George E. Ayers is the executive director of The Council for Exceptional Children. Prior to joining CEC in July, 1992, Dr. Ayers was vice president for academic programs at the American Association of State Colleges and Universities and director of the Academic Affairs Resource Center.

Dr. Ayers received his B.S. degree from Western Illinois University and M.A. and doctorate from the University of Northern Colorado. Since completing his doctoral program in rehabilitation counseling and education psychology in 1965, Dr. Ayers has worked as an instructor in physical medicine and rehabilitation at Case Western Reserve University; professor and director of rehabilitation counseling at Mankato State University; vice president and dean of the faculty and professor of urban education at Metropolitan State University; president of Massasoit Community College; president of Chicago State University; and a senior fellow at AASCU until he assumed the position of vice president at the association in 1989.

Active in many professional organizations, Dr. Ayers serves as chair of the U.S. Small Business Development Center National Advisory Committee and on the board of directors for the Harvard University Institute for the Management of Lifelong Education, American Association of University Administrators, International House, and the

American Association of Higher Education Black Caucus. He is also a member of the National Governors' Forum on Excellence at Work and serves as advisor for the Kellogg Foundation National Fellowship Program.

Dr. Ayers has served on the board of directors for many community organizations, including the Chicago Symphony Orchestra, the Black Creativity Advisory Committee of the Chicago Museum of Science and Industry, the Illinois Arts Alliance, Leadership Greater Chicago, Boy Scouts of America, and the National Conference of Christians and Jews.

A prolific writer, Dr. Ayers has published over sixty articles, monographs and books on professional education. He has traveled throughout the world, lectured extensively on education issues, and been a consultant to numerous educational institutions, corporations and community agencies.

Dr. Ayers is listed in Two Thousand Men of Achievement, Leaders in Education, Who's Who in Personalities in the West and Midwest, Who's Who in Education, Who's Who Among Black Americans, and has been a recipient of many awards from professional organizations and associations including honorary doctorate degrees from Empire State College of the State University of New York and East/West University in Chicago.

ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities — Bologna, Paris, Oxford — the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern-day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of American colleges and universities, too, may wear regalia which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown

State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has a vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The recessional at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of University Honors will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
