Youngstown, Ohio - "An Anthology of Sacred Hymns for Classical Guitar," National Public Radio's special Easter program, will be aired at 11 a.m. Sunday, March 30, over WYSU-FM (88.5), Youngstown State University's fine arts radio station.

Featuring talented American Guitarist James Sundquist, the one-hour program traces the evolution of specific hymns, as well as of the hymn as a musical form. With music and narration, the program takes listeners through this rich musical history, from the psalms of David and medieval Gregorian chants to the modern hymn, which began to emerge during the Reformation.

Host Robert Montiegel will share with listeners the fascinating events that brought texts and music together.
