YOUNGSTOWN, Ohio - Chi Sigma Iota and the Counseling Department of Youngstown State University will sponsor the lecture, "Innovations in the Private Delivery of Mental Health Services" at 8 p.m. Tuesday, June 3, on the YSU campus.
