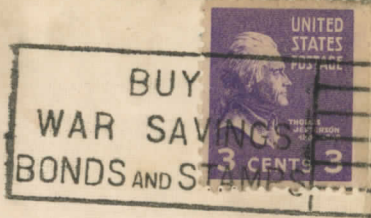
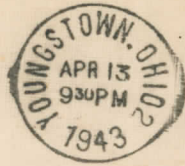

You tell me be good, I'm good you better be good or else well you then will be bad. But I hope my honey is a good fellow. What do you say?

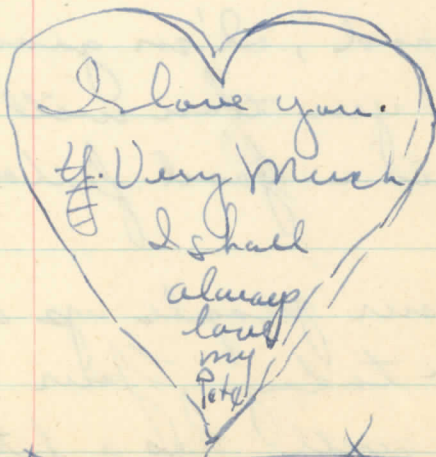
I just called your people up and they got a letter from you today. Your brother I guess isn't feeling very well has a little cold but every body has a cold. This weather
