

A Resolution to Request Student Government Involvement in Reconstructing the *Principles of Good Practices for Classroom Management and Participation*

- WHEREAS,** Youngstown State University Students and Faculty share simultaneous dissatisfaction as a result of limited elaboration on Student rights and responsibilities within the classroom;
- WHEREAS,** Students do not possess a centralized document or location to view all their university-afforded rights in the classroom; and adversely, Faculty maintain rightful expectations during the semester that portions of Students struggle to remain cognizant of;
- WHEREAS,** Sometimes, this lapse in documentation and transparency hinders the Student-Faculty relationship within academic settings and leads to feelings of frustration and discontent for both parties; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED,** That the Academic Senate here assembled, reframe the *Principles of Good Practice in Teaching* to include a restructured format revolving around classroom/course management, participation, and Students' rights and proper responsibilities within the classroom; and be it further
- RESOLVED,** By request of Youngstown State University's Student Government Association, that the Academic Senate here assembled allow for a cohesive effort by its various Committees and the *Legislative Body* of Student Government to collaborate on a joint solution to the aforementioned issue.
