Robert H. Sweeney, a graduate of Boardman High School, has been in the automotive business since 1958. A graduate of Case Western Reserve University with a degree in Mechanical Engineering, Mr. Sweeney worked for Rockwell Industries upon graduation. While working for Rockwell, who was making tank parts for the Cleveland Tank Plant, he decided he wanted to be involved in the automotive business. An offer from the Buick Agency started Mr. Sweeney on a career in the automotive industry that spanned over 46 years.

Community service has been a large part of Mr. Sweeney's life in the Mahoning Valley. He has served on the boards of Western Reserve Care System, Stambaugh Auditorium, Bank One, Torent, Inc. and the Butler Institute of American Art, where he created and supports the Sweeney Children's Gallery in memory of his mother and father. He also serves on the board of the YSU Foundation. Mr. Sweeney served as the Easter Seal Society's Campaign Chairman in 1979.

He has been a member of the National Auto Dealers Association since 1952, serving on the Industry Relations Committee twice. He has been a member of the Auto Dealers Association of Eastern Ohio since its founding in 1964, serving twice as a Trustee and as President for two years in 1978.

Mr. Sweeney received the Youngstown Warren Regional Chamber of Commerce Small Business Man of the Year Award in 1996, an honor never before bestowed by this Chamber on an auto dealer. In 1997 Mr. Sweeney was one of the top ten finalists for Time Magazine's Quality Dealer Award, "the most prestigious award a new car dealer can receive." Dealers are selected for their "outstanding performances, as automobile dealers and as valued citizens of the communities."
