



Fraternity house vandalized

Investigations continue to discover the identities of several individuals believed to have been involved in an incident of vandalism at the Theta Chi fraternity house at 742 Bryson Street.

Early Wednesday morning at approximately 1:17 a.m., Theta Chi Fraternity members reported to Youngstown City Police that some unidentified persons broke 16 assorted win-

dows of their fraternity house by using baseball bats and bricks.

According to police reports, a fraternity member reported to Patrolman Joe Wess of YPD that "the fraternity had been receiving several threatening phone calls since last Friday, April 12, from unidentified persons who supposedly claimed to be members of the YSU football

team."

Police reports said the fraternity member told police that the fraternity believed there was "no apparent reason" for the phone calls or the vandalism.

A hearing has been scheduled for sometime next week to investigate allegations that members of the YSU football team may have been involved in the incident.
