

# Pollock House to remain standing; \$8,000 is allocated for renovation

The University has allocated \$8,000 for the renovation of Pollock House.

ROTC, which conduct its classes in Pollock House, requested campus development to investigate the building's condition.

Director of Campus Development, Nick Leonelli, said after an investigation it was found "We would have to fix or

move. We have no place to put ROTC so we decided to fix." With these findings campus development approached the budget committee for funds.

Leonelli said the main purpose of the renovation is to make Pollock House "a little more presentable and practical."

The repairs will include wiring, painting, carpeting and installing bulletin boards.

Leonelli said the purchase order was requested Oct. 14, and work should begin "within a couple of weeks." He said the work will "depend on the laying of the carpet," but it will be "eight weeks at the most" before the work is done.

Pollock House will be used by ROTC and the Youngstown Education Foundation when the work is completed.
