Dr. Bullough Has Article Published In Medical Bulletin

Dr. Verne Bullough, of the history faculty of Youngstown University, has written an article which appeared in the last issue of the "Bulletin of the History of Medicine" which is published jointly by Johns Hopkins University and the History of Medicine Society.

Dr. Bullough's article is titled "The Development of the Medical

University at Montpellier to the End of the Fourteenth Century."

His article traces the development of the bachelor's, master's, and doctor's degrees in arts and in medicine. Montpellier University, Montpellier, France, was the first university to offer the medical degree.
