



YSU swim team breaks Guinness world swim record

This past weekend, arms, legs and feet went splash in the YSU swimming pool as the YSU swim team proceeded to break the Guinness world record of swimming 100 continuous miles. Twenty swimmers swam in three hour shifts, averaging 357 laps per swimmer as they eclipsed the old mark of 25 hours, 55 minutes, 8.2 seconds with a new mark of 23 hours, 57 minutes, 42.3

seconds.

During the record-breaking performance the swimmers raised \$1,500 to finance a trip to Florida over the Christmas break in December.
