

Prof. Wm. H. Taft To Resign Position

Prof. William H. Taft, of the business administration and English departments, has resigned from the Youngstown College faculty, effective at the end of the summer session. Mr. Taft has accepted a position at a smaller college in the western part of the state, as professor of journalism and director of public relations. He assumes his new duties Sept. 1.

During his 2½ years at Youngstown College, Mr. Taft was faculty advisor of the JAMBAR, which won first place in the state contests this year, and third place last year. He was also instrumental in expanding the advertising courses in the business administration department, and adding courses in journalism and public relations to the curriculum.

While teaching at Youngstown, Mr. Taft has also been carrying courses at Western Reserve University, and expects to complete his classroom requirements for his Ph.D. next summer.
