

College Seeks Information on Potential Students of R.O.T.C. Assuming Program Were to Be Inaugurated as Course Here

Application for the establishment of a unit of the Reserve Officers Training Corps will be made by the administration of Youngstown College if enough students are interested in such a course.

R. O. T. C. consists of a four-year course of 512 hours in actual training. Graduation requirements are as follows:

First Year
96 hours 3 hours per week

Second Year
96 hours 3 hours per week

Third Year
160 hours 5 hours per week

Fourth Year
160 hours 5 hours per week

The army and air forces require two weeks at a designated training field after completion of academic studies before issuance of a

reserve officer's commission in the grade of second lieutenant.

The navy requires two years active duty after receiving a commission in the grade of ensign.

Many Courses Offered

Courses offered under R.O.T.C. training include military organization, hygiene and first aid, leadership, exercise of command, weapons and marksmanship, map reading, military science, physical development, military administration, evolution of warfare, military laws and boards, military tactics and technique, etc.

A subsistence allowance of \$25 per month is given to third and fourth year students under the plan. First and second year students are furnished uniforms and necessary equipment. Veterans do

not have to take the first two years.

Science Credit Given

Non laboratory science credit would be given students enrolled in the military science courses if YoCo were to offer them, the administration announced.
