Tuition at Youngstown College Raised to \$224

Tuition at Youngstown College will be raised to \$224 a year, effective this fall semester, Dr. Howard W. Jones, president announced today.

Dr. Jones said this increase amounts to only \$12 a semester. It was decided upon after officials had made a study of expenses. They indicated this to be the minimum amount of increase necessary to maintain educational standards required by accrediting agencies.

Tuition will still be low, Dr. Jones explained. A recent survey made by the president of an Ohio college showed that the average yearly tuition for Ohio colleges is \$293, including state schools. When state schools are not included, the average yearly tuition is about \$315. Youngstown College is the only Ohio co-educational college accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools whose tuition is as low as \$200 a year, with the exception of state and municipal universities.
