Enrollment Up Over Last Year

Final figures are tabulated for the second semester at Youngstown University showing a total enrollment for the semester of 5,655 students, an increase of 332 over enrollment for last year at this time.

A breakdown shows the highest enrollment in liberal arts with a total of 1,970. Other schools follow in order of highest enrollment: business administration, 1,481; engineering, 1,243; education, 851 and music, 110.

The high liberal arts enrollment is partially accounted for by the fact that education students now are enrolled in liberal arts for the first two years of their curriculum. Engineering enrollment is slightly lower than that of last year. All basic science classes are filled.
