

# SPRING VACATION CANCELLED

## Yoco Co-operates With National Defense Move

There will be no spring vacation at Youngstown college this year! President Howard W. Jones recently announced that the annual spring vacation would be cancelled and a full 12-week summer course offered as a part of the national defense program. This schedule, requested of all colleges by the War and Navy departments, will enable students to complete a full college course in three years.

The second semester, according to President Jones, will be completed one week earlier. The summer course will begin immediately with a full freshman schedule being offered. A full schedule is also available for freshmen beginning school at the second semester, February 2.

### New Courses Offered

Dr. Clarence P. Gould has been appointed to organize classes in meteorology, navigation and signals. The Morse code will be included in the latter. Dr. Gould will instruct classes which will begin the second semester, February 2.

For the past several years the college has offered courses in conjunction with national defense. At present there are courses in civilian pilot training, materials testing, machine detail, machine design, production supervision and fuels.
