

College Enrollment for Second Semester to Be 2,200, 770 Veterans

Registration Will Remain Open Until Jan. 19

Registration records show that over 2,200 students have enrolled in Youngstown College for next semester with night school registration remaining open until Jan. 19. Of these students, 770 are veterans, totalling more than most of the nation's college veteran enrollment.

A break-down shows 583 of the total are new veterans, with 75 of these being former students of the college. The current semester veteran enrollment is 187 ex-servicemen.

College officials have scheduled classrooms outside the college buildings to cope with the greatly enlarged student body. A few classes will be held in the William Rayen Technical Institute, while the entire building is to be opened for use March 1. Until that time lectures will be given in nearby churches and public buildings.
