

President Bush visits campus

President Bush led a panel discussion on community health centers in Spotlight Arena Theater in Bliss Hall on May 25. It is the first time a sitting president has visited YSU in the campus' 96-year history. About 250 invited guests, including several YSU trustees and administrators, attended the 45-minute event, which attracted dozens of national news reporters. While the president was inside Bliss Hall, a crowd of about 200 protesters and supporters gathered outside, waving signs and chanting slogans.

The president's visit resulted in prominent mentions of YSU in newspapers from New York to Seattle. *The New York Times*, *USA Today*, *Washington Post*, *Chicago Tribune* and the *Seattle Post-Intelligencer* were among the newspapers that included YSU in their stories.
