SUBJECT Change of Minimum Grade Point Average During the Probationary Period

In response to the decision of the Dean's Council to change the minimum grade point average for students on probation, the Academic Affairs Committee has voted to recommend the following version for the Senate's approval.

From the last sentence in the first column on page 50, it is recommended:

"If at the end of the probationary quarter he has failed to bring his average up to the minimum, he will be suspended; however, if he makes substantial improvement during a probationary quarter and averages at least 2.00 for that quarter, he will be continued on probation even though his cumulative average does not meet the minimum."
