To offer $501,502,503$ in one 8 week session means that day classes meeting 5 days per week need to be scheduled for 3 hours; evening class meeting 4 days per week needs to be scheduled for 4 hours.

Based on what we have done in the past, we would offer these classes:
0800-1050 ( 5 days [one 15 minute break/day])
1000-1250 ( 5 days [one 15 minute break/day])
1300-1550 ( 5 days [one 15 minute break/day])
1740-2130 (4 days [one 15 minute break/day])
FYI - Here are my calculations:
40 hours of instruction +2 hours for final $=42$ hours for each course $\times 3$ courses $=126$ hours of class time.
In 8 weeks there are 40 days of instruction when meeting 5 days / week
In 8 weeks there are 32 days of instruction when meeting 4 days / week
126 hours / 40 days $=3.15$ hours or 3 hours and 9 minutes per day.
126 hours / 32 days $=3.94$ hours or 3 hours and 57 minutes per day.
