ARTS & SCIENCES: The environmental studies program proposal involving choice of core courses was approved.

FINE & PERFORMING ARTS: The Music Theatre proposal is being returned because hours in the new proposed program do not add up. The committee counts 133 total hours instead of the stated 123.
