THE ACADEMIC STANDARDS & EVENTS COMMITTEE 3rd Meeting, October 19, 1983

PRESENT: Peter Von Ostwalden, Chairman; Braden, Earnhart, Hassell, McGraw, Munro, Rost, Scriven, Stocks

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m.

OLD BUSINESS

- 1) Minutes of October 12 were corrected by adding that Duane Rost, ex-officio member, is the Chairman of the Academic Programs and Curriculum Committee.
- 2) Von Ostwalden commented on some major topics covered at the workshop on General Education which he attended at Slippery Rock University.

NEW BUSINESS

- 1) It was agreed upon that the format on page 40 of the 1982-83 YSU Bulletin would be an appropriate starting point for formulating the rationale of the Proposal. Committee members were assigned to rewrite the individual sections on page 40 in accordance with the recommended requirements contained in the Proposal, to be submitted at our October 26 meeting.
- 2) Dean Scriven suggested that the effective date of implementation be specified in the Proposal, and that the requirements be applicable to Freshmen registered for classes after June I, 1984.
- 3) Munro suggested that we proceed in the following order when preparing the Proposal and presentation to the Senate: 1) definition of the areas and recommended requirements, 2) rationale, and 3) courses that may apply to each requirement.

Earnhart, on the other hand, believes that the rationale should be presented first, so as to introduce and promote the ideas leading up to the Proposal.

4) Regarding the question of whether or not the format of the Ad Hoc Committee on General Requirements Report of June 2, 1981 ("Gould Report") should be adopted, it was decided that this is not necessary.
