Subject 1. The value of certain grades

2. A student advisory system

Recommendations:

1. A revised definition of the "C" grade as discussed in the catalogue, removing from it any suggestion that it represents unsatisfactory work.

2. A definite definition of the general grades, "S", "P", and "E".

3. The present student advisory system should be made more rigid. The departmental heads should be given lists of their majors and minors; those students who do not signify major and minor work, should be arbitrarily assigned to advisers at registration.
