

The entire meeting was devoted to the proposal of Dean Dykema dated 29 June 1970, wherein the matter of recording pluses and minuses on final grade reports was scrutinized. It was reported to the members of the Committee that the Computer Center can record these grade distinctions. The discussion that followed touched on these issues: a suggestion to change the present grading system of letter grades and move to a numerical system; the difficulty in getting faculty in varying disciplines to grade in the same way; the need to get more opinions pro and con the Dykema proposal from students, faculty, and administrators; the desire to look at other colleges and universities to see what their grading policies are. All of this was deemed necessary before the Committee could make a determination.
