In early spring of this year, officers of certain private colleges in Ohio met to discuss a joint funds solicitation of business and industry along the pattern set up in 1949 by a group of Michigan schools. After two general meetings, a proposed constitution for such an organization was drawn up by a committee composed of the presidents of Western College, Otterbein, Oberlin, John Carroll, and Capital University.

This constitution has been submitted to Youngstown College as a non-tax-supported institution of higher learning in Ohio, with an invitation to join the Foundation. The proposal is here presented for the consideration of the Board of Trustees.

The major purposes of the Foundation are to solicit funds from corporations and foundations for the benefit of the operating budgets of member colleges, and to distribute to the member colleges funds thus secured (60% divided equally among members; 40% divided proportionately according to enrollment).

Two additional provisions are that (1) "To continue as a member in good standing each college shall be expected to provide its allocated share of the total budget (for financing the Foundation organization) and such services by its President as shall be stipulated by the Board of Directors"; (2) "It was agreed that to make the operation of this proposed Foundation effective each college president should accept the obligation to submit a list of at least 25 corporations or foundations as potential prospects and agree to give at least two weeks of his time during the year to the canvassing of prospects in behalf of the Foundation".

5. R.O.T.C.

Major Robert S. Stacy has been appointed Professor of Military Science and Tactics for the College Antiaircraft Artillery Unit of the Senior Division Reserve Officers' Training Corps. The appointment of an Assistant Professor and several non-commissioned men will be made shortly by the Department of the Army.

The two offices of the unit will be housed in Pollock Hall, which is undergoing minor construction changes required by city fire department regulations. Equipment will be kept in Pollock Hall garages and the basement, and in an annex building.

Enrollment in the unit will be drawn primarily from the freshman class, as few upperclassmen with the required Army background can fit the classes in military science into their degree programs.

Resolutions of the Board of Trustees are required by the Department of the Army, delegating to the President power to contract with the Army in the name of the College, and appointing the Business Manager as Military Property Custodian. Copies of these resolutions must be filed immediately with the bond for \$165,000 which is required of the College to cover Army equipment for the unit.

6. Enrollment

Summer school enrollment is expected to be 1600 students, in comparison with enrollments of about 2,000 the summers of 1948 and 1949.

Over 2400 students currently enrolled have completed their pre-registration for the fall term. A freshman class of 800 is anticipated. It is probable that there will be an overall enrollment drop of at least 10%, in comparison with this year's student body. Although the deadline on applications for veterans' educational benefits is July 1951, it is doubtful that there will be any last-minute veteran rush in enrollments.

8. Rayen School of Engineering

Mr. Frank Ellis, assistant professor in physics, has been appointed acting dean of the Engineering School, pending a permanent appointment to this position. The man assuming leadership of the engineering school should combine academic training with a broad background of industrial experience. A number of men are under consideration for the appointment.

Application to the Engineers' Council for Professional Development for an accreditation inspection has been postponed for a year, until the faculty replacements at the Engineering School have been made.

9. Student Placement Office

The Ohio State Employment Service Director of Placement at the College has reported that between 90-95% of the students applying to him for summer work have been referred to jobs and, with few exceptions, placed. This is remarkable in view of the national employment situation and indicates an excellent working relationship between local firms and the College Placement Office.

10. Alumni Bulletin

Under the editorship of Mr. Freed, journalism instructor, the journalism class is preparing an alumni bulletin to be mailed to approximately 2200 former students at the College. This is the first time a newsheet has been sent to alumni, and it will serve as a summary report on major changes at the College since 1940.
