### **Historical Sketch**

The history of the library at Youngstown State University goes back to the 1930s during YSU's Youngstown College days. During this time Youngstown College was loosely under the control of the Youngstown Young Men's Christian Association. The library at Youngstown College was located in the Main Building (now called Jones Hall). At that time, the library mainly consisted of law books because the Youngstown Public Library was located across the street and funds went to purchasing books which the YPL did not own. It was not until the College broke away from the Y.M.C.A. that it sought accreditation and a large space to build a true college library.

The library's first real permanent home was the fourth floor of the Main Building (Jones Hall). There it remained from the 1936 to the opening of the new library (now Tod Hall) in 1953. Eventually, the library grew to such an extent that a larger facility had to be built in the 1970s. Since 1976, the YSU library has been housed in the William F. Maag, Jr.

Library.

The best way to relate the history of the YSU library is to describe the head librarians and/or directors who were in charge and the changes they brought to the library. Below is a list of head librarians/directors with the dates of the time they were at the YSU library.

Constance Robinson (1935-1937) Miss Robinson graduated from Hiram College and received her Bachelor of Science in Library Science from Western Reserve. She was appointed as Library of Youngstown College during a Board of Governors meeting March 1935. The facilities of the library were located on the fourth floor and were restricted on space and lacked an adequate library. She left the college shortly after marrying Dale Perren and moved to Jackson, Michigan.

Maurine Brunner (1937-1947) Prior to coming to Youngstown College, Miss Brunner worked 10 years in the library of Adelbert College of Western Reserve. She received her A.B. degree at Ohio State University, B.L.S. from the School of Library Sciences at Western Reserve and a M.A. from Western Reserve. Under Brunner the library started to develop through book donations and fundraising from the Friends of Youngstown College Library (est. 1939). In 1942, she had the school participate in the Victory Book campaign in which donated books were sent to army training camps for troops. She resigned from her position after 10 years to become the librarian of the Supreme Court of Missouri.

**Dr. Ivan Grimshaw** (1947-1950) Mr. Grimshaw came to YoCo from Santiago, Chile where he had been the rector of the Instituto Ingles. He received his bachelor of arts from Hiram College, bachelor of divinity from Yale University, Master of Arts from University of Chicago, a doctor of philosophy degree from the University of Edinburgh, and a bachelor of library science degree from Columbia University. During Grimshaw's time as librarian, the library received a micro-library reader. Youngstown College was the first Ohio school to install one.

James W. Pirie (1951-1957) Mr. Pirie came to Youngstown College from the Harvard College Lamont Library where he served as administrative assistant and head of the gift exchange division and reference librarian. He co-authored the *Lamont Library Handbook*. He worked with the architects during the designing of the new library (Tod Hall) which was dedicated in 1953. The building had a capacity for 260,000 volumes and seated 600 people. He helped Youngstown College develop a Librarian Training program in compliance with the local and nationwide need for trained librarians. He also began the library record collection.

**Dr. George Jones** (1957-1974) Dr. Jones came to Youngstown from Northfield where he was librarian of the Northfield Community Library. He received is degreed of Bachelor of Arts from Oberlin College, a Masters in Arts from Harvard University, his Master's Degree in Library Science from Kent State University and a doctor of philosophy degree from Harvard in 1966. During Jones tenure as head librarian, he sought to purchase larger older scholarly works to appeal to students. In 1959, he purchased Denis Diderot's *Encyclopedia* from 1753 with funds raised by students. He was also appointed to the board of the Youngstown Historical Society. Jones oversaw the conversion from the Dewey decimal system to the Library of Congress cataloging system. It also became

apparent that the library began to outgrow its home and plans began for a larger library building. In 1969, Jones attempted to close the library for an hour in support of the campus wide Moratorium on the Vietnam War, but under the urging of YSU Administration, he kept it opened with limited staff. Under Jones' direction, the number of books in the library increased from 68,000 to 340,000, with an increase in staff to 12 professional librarians, 26 support staffers, and 35 student assistants. He retired in 1974.

Richard Owen (1974-1980) Mr. Richard Owen came to Youngstown State University from Heidelberg College where he was the director of Library services. During the summer 1975 (right before the move to Maag), Tod Hall flooded during a storm and as a result, 8,000 were damaged and had to be sent to the Falcon Foundry in Lowellville where the books were baked to dry. During his time as director the library moved from Tod Hall to Maag Library, which was completed in 1975. The library also implemented the "tattle-tape" security system to enable thefts. The library installed its first public service computer terminal in 1976 to help students and faculty locate materials. In 1977 the Government Documents Collection at YSU was named for Ohio's 19<sup>th</sup> District Congressman Charles J. Carney, much of the government document collection was donated by him. The library received an automated library circulation system which was the first self-contained unity at any Ohio state university. Owen was named university archivist and special collection librarian January 1, 1980. He retired in 1984 due to health issues.

Dr. David Genaway (1980-1996) Before coming to YSU, Dr. Genaway was the associate dean of libraries and learning resources at Eastern Kentucky University, librarian at Waite Memorial Library at the University of Minnesota, library director at Dakota State College and various other positions at collegiate institutions. He received a bachelor's from Atlantic Union College, a Master's degree from Andrews University, a Master's in Library Science from the University of Michigan and Doctor's degree from the University of Minnesota. Developments in the library during Genaway's tenure were: access to on-line database searching (1981), the use of MARC, established use of the VTLS on-line library system, the library underwent renovations in 1988, invested in InfoTrac system on the computers, dealt with major budget cuts in 1992, purchased a 31 year gap of *The Vindicator* in microfilm, installed the Arkenstone Reading Machine to aid the visually impaired, started to store materials at the Northeastern Ohio Cooperative Regional Library Depository which opened in 1993, and became part of OhioLINK (an inter-electronic loan system) in 1993. He was an active member in the Academic Senate Library and Computer committees. He wrote a detailed guide in *The Electronic Library* magazine entitled: "Online Library Systems: A Decision-Marking Guide for Library Managers." He was appointed a two year term on the Research Committee of the National Association of College and Research Libraries. He retired after 16 years of service on August 1, 1996.

Thomas Atwood (1996-2002) Mr. Thomas Atwood began as an Interim director of the library after the retirement of David Genaway. He was finally appointed official director in 2000. Atwood had 15 years of experience at Maag Library prior to his official appointment asas director. He began as a humanities microforms librarian, to the head of cataloguing and finally as a system librarian prior to being appointed as interim director. He received both his bachelors and masters degrees from YSU and his Master's Degree in Library Science from Florida State University. During Atwood's time as director, the electronic journals made available through Maag and OhioLINK grew tremendously.

Maag Library received its first computer lab for students as well as a bibliographic instruction room for teaching library-related research. Due to missing or misshelving periodicals, it was determined to keep all periodicals and serials under closed stacks. Talk began between the Atwood and then YSU President, David Sweet, for an Archives and Special Collections. Atwood left Maag in August 2002 to become director and chief medical librarian at the Oliver Ocasek Region Medical Information Center at Northeastern Ohio Universities College of Medicine. Jan Schnall served as interim until July 2003.

Paul Kobulnicky (2003-2011) Prior to coming to YSU, Mr. Kobulnicky had been the vice chancellor for information services and chief information officer at the University Connecticut since 1999. He was previously university director of libraries at UConn, and also interim director and deputy director at the University Library System at the University of Pittsburgh. He has a Bachelor of Science degree from Pennsylvania State University and a Master's degree in Administration and Systems Analysis from the University of Pittsburgh. Maag Library acquired wireless internet, the interior was remodeled with a café located on the third floor, an Archives and Special Collections on the fifth floor, and classroom space in the basement. He also had circulation policies moved to a semester-base loan term in 2009. In 2011, Paul Kobulnicky was transfered from his position at the library to a position in the Office of Finance and Administration where he stayed till his official retirement in March 2014.

Currently Maag library has two interim directors who are co-directors. Mr. Jeffrey Trimble manages library related issues in regards to information services. Ms. Ana Torres is the manager of Library Operation and takes care of the day to day operation and business aspects of the library.

### **Scope and Content Note**

This collection was compiled of several acquisitions all existing within Maag Library. Due to repetition of series and materials, original order was not met. The collections were combined into series and arranged alphabetically. Multiple duplicates of items were disregarded keeping only two of each as according to standard archival procedure. A majority of the materials were from Richard Owen, David Genaway, and Tom Atwood's times as directors (1974-2002). The only issue pertaining to this collection is the potential add-ons from future directors.

### **Series III: Facilities and Networks**

The Facilities and Networks series contains materials relating to the physical building and housing of the library at Youngstown State University as well as the Networks the library participates in. Tod Hall was the University's library from 1953-1975, prior to that the library was located on the fourth floor of Jones Hall. Since the Library sends materials to the depository in Rootstown, Ohio the Cooperative Regional Library Depository is included as a facility in this series.
