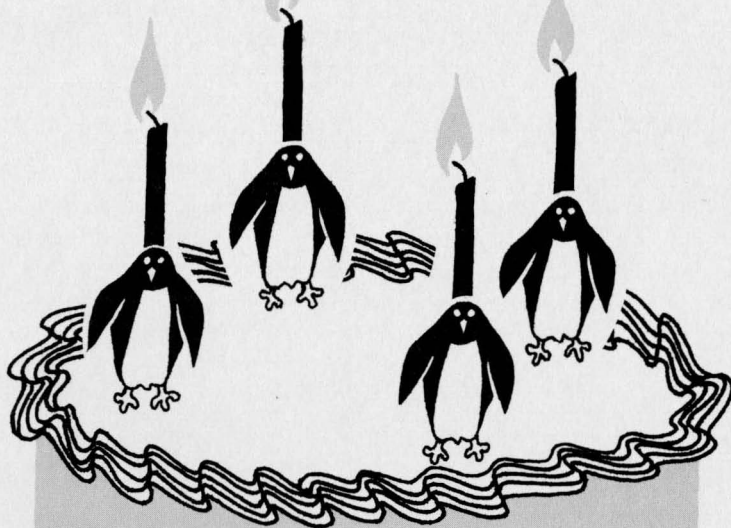

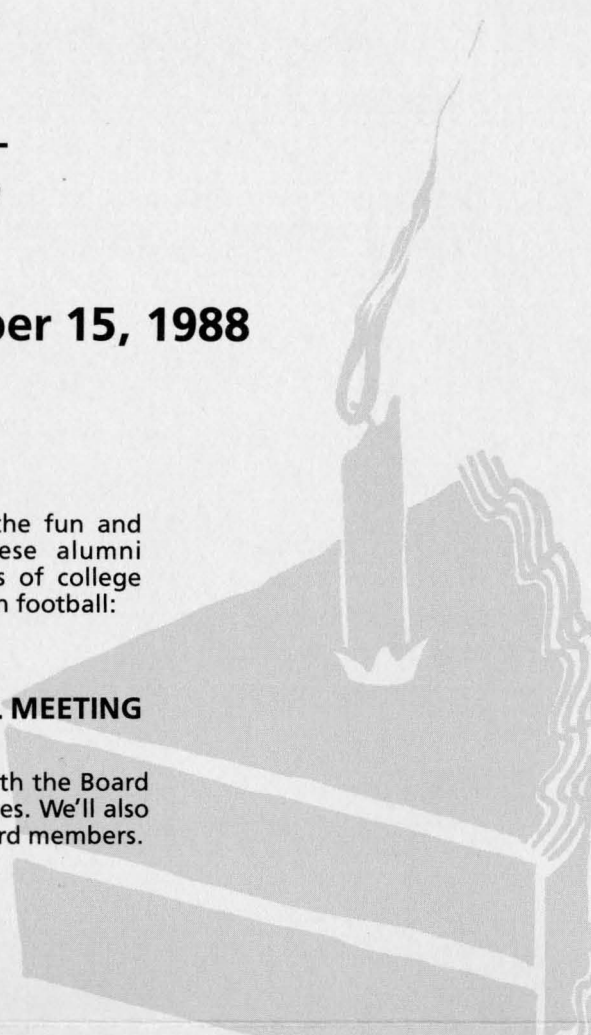

Tee was known as "Mr. Music" in his early days as a Big Band Leader, TV-Radio and Recording Artist. He later went on to be a teacher and businessman for 33 years. Ross had one of the largest music studios in the Youngstown area, where thousands of youngsters got their musical start.
