Candidate For The Honorary Degree

DOCTOR OF LAWS SIDNEY RIGELHAUPT

Youngstown State University today confers the degree Doctor of Laws on distinguished jurist Sidney Rigelhaupt, whose lifelong career in law has been dedicated to serving his profession and the community. Recently retired from the bench of the Mahoning County Common Pleas Court, Judge Rigelhaupt left the permanent mark of his outstanding service on the position he held for twelve years.

A Youngstown native and a graduate of Rayen High School, Judge Rigelhaupt earned a law degree in 1926 from the Youngstown Institute of Technology, the college which later became Youngstown State University. From 1926 to 1963 he was engaged in the private practice of general law in Youngstown. During that time, he helped found the Legal Aid Society which he served as president for seventeen terms, served as vice chairman of the Ohio Bar Association, and was president and a trustee of the Mahoning County Bar Association. In 1963, he was elected to the first of two successive, six-year terms as judge of the Mahoning County Common Pleas Court. He also served as judge of the Special

Court of Jurisdiction of the Mahoning Valley Sanitary District. Because state law restricting the age of candidates for judicial office prevented him from running for a third term, he retired from the bench in December 1974 and returned to private practice. Currently on special assignment to the Trumbull County Common Pleas Court, he hears civil cases in that court.

Judge Rigelhaupt has long been active in civic organizations and community projects. He served as chairman of the panels for negotiation between the Campbell Board of Education and the Campbell Education Association, and the Youngstown Board of Education and the Youngstown Education Association. He is a member of the Ohio Common Pleas Judges' Association, and has served as president of the Youngstown College Alumni Association and the Youngstown Law School Alumni Association.

Judge Rigelhaupt holds the Outstanding Judiciary Service Award of the Mahoning County Bar Association, the Judicial Service Award of the Ohio Supreme Court, and the Maennerchor Society's Man of the Year Award.

ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities—Bologna, Paris, Oxford—the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. For instance, the lining of the hood placed this morning over the head of the recipient of the honorary degree is cardinal and white, the colors of Youngstown State University. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters, or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education. It is possible, also, to determine from the length of the hoods the type of degree held by the wearer—quite long for the doctor's degree, medium for the master's, short for the bachelor's.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of

American colleges and universities, too, may wear regalia which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The procession at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of **University Honors** will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
