## The Commencement Speaker

### DR. PAUL L. DRESSEL

A graduate of Youngstown College and a native of Youngstown, Dr. Paul L. Dressel has served Michigan State University for nearly 40 years, the last 19 as Professor of University Research.

Dr. Dressel began his academic career at Michigan State in 1934 as an instructor and assistant professor of mathematics, when the school was known as Michigan State College. He has served as director of the Orientation Office; director of Counseling and chairman, Board of Examiners; professor and director, Office of Evaluation Services; assistant provost, director of Institutional Research; and assistant provost for Institutional Research. He also spent four years as director of the Cooperative Study of Evaluation in General Education for the American Council on Education.

Dr. Dressel has distinguished himself in other areas of academia nationwide, chairing the Commission of Scholars for the Illinois State Board of Higher Education and the Task Force on Professionalism of the Newspaper Journalist for the American Newspaper Publishers Association. He currently is a member of the Commission on Higher Education of the Middle States Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools, the Commission of Colleges for the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, and the Advisory Committee to the Northwest Area Foundation. He is consulting editor to both "Research in Higher Education" and "The Journal of Experimental Education."

A consultant to the Council on Public Higher Education for the Commonwealth of Kentucky and the Board for Higher Education for the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, as well as to numerous colleges and universities on problems of evaluation and curriculum development. Dr. Dressel is past president and chairman of the Committee on General Education for the American Association of Higher Education, of which he is a member. He also holds memberships in the American Educational Research Association, the National Society for the Study of Education, the American Psychological Association, the American Association for the Advancement of Science, plus other societies and professional organizations.

The author of articles on evaluation, counseling, testing, curriculum development and revision, instruction and research in higher education, Dr. Dressel is noted for his works on these topics. Some of his most recent publications are *The Confidence Crisis*, *The World of Higher Education*, *Institutional Research in the University: A Handbook*, *College Teaching: Improvement by Degrees*, and the *Handbook of Academic Evaluation*.

Dr. Dressel received an Associate in Arts degree from Youngstown College in 1929, earning a Bachelor of Arts degree from Wittenberg University, a Master of Arts from Michigan State College, and his Ph.D. from the University of Michigan. He also is the recipient of an Honorary Doctor of Laws degree from Wittenberg University.

## ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities—Bologna, Paris, Oxford—the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. For instance, the lining of the hood placed this morning over the head of the recipient of the honorary degree is cardinal and white, the colors of Youngstown State University. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters, or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education. It is possible, also, to determine from the length of the hoods the type of degree held by the wearer—quite long for the doctor's degree, medium for the master's, short for the bachelor's.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of

American colleges and universities, too, may wear regalia which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The procession at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of **University Honors** will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
