THE COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

THE MOST REVEREND JAMES W. MALONE, bishop of the Diocese of Youngstown and president of the National Conference of Catholic Bishops, will deliver the Commencement address.

Bishop Malone, who has devoted his entire career as a priest to the 300,000-member Youngstown Diocese, was appointed bishop in 1968. Ordained as a priest in 1945, he subsequently served as associate pastor at St. Columba Cathedral, superintendent of the diocesan schools, auxiliary bishop, vicar general and apostolic administrator.

Bishop Malone has worked with the National Conference of Catholic Bishops for 23 years, and last November was elected to a three-year term as its president. There are 375 cardinals, archbishops and bishops in the conference and together they represent 52 million Catholics. Working with the Vatican, the conference establishes policy for the American Catholic Church and represents American Catholics at the Vatican.

The bishop has also served as a board member of the United States Catholic Conference, the Catholic Conference of Ohio, and the Ohio Council of Churches. He has been active locally with many organizations, including United Appeal, Interfaith Campus Ministry, Catholic Charities, American Cancer Society, Boy Scout Council, and others.

A native of Youngstown, the bishop attended St. Charles College, Catonsville, Maryland, and St. Mary Seminary, Cleveland. He received his doctoral degree from Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C.

In 1969, Bishop Malone received an honorary Doctor of Humane Letters degree from YSU. He also holds honorary degrees from Walsh College, Canton, and the University of Vermont, and recently received an honorary degree from the University of Steubenville.

CANDIDATE FOR THE HONORARY DEGREE DOCTOR OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

EDWARD J. DeBARTOLO, a native of Youngstown, was educated at the University of Notre Dame as a civil engineer and by 1948 had founded the corporation which is the nation's leading developer of regional shopping centers. As chairman of the board and chief executive officer of The Edward J. DeBartolo Corporation, he has been responsible for the development of more than 60,000,000 square feet of enclosed malls and major shopping centers in cities across the United States.

The stepson of an Italian-born contractor to whom he credits his belief in the work ethic, Mr. DeBartolo and his family are directly involved in the daily operation of the billion-dollar business which bears his name. Since the opening of his first suburban shopping center in 1949, Mr. DeBartolo's interests have expanded to include residential communities, high-rise office buildings, hotels and motels, industrial and executive office parks, athletic teams and sports and entertainment facilities.

Mr. DeBartolo and his family are believed to be the nation's largest single investor in sports enterprises, owning: three racetracks — Balmoral Park in Chicago, Louisiana Downs in Shreveport, and Thistledown Racing Club in Cleveland; a soccer club, the Pittsburgh Spirit of the Major Indoor Soccer League; a hockey franchise, the Pittsburgh Penguins of the National Hockey League; the Pittsburgh Civic and Sports Arena; the recently awarded new United States Football League franchise, the Pittsburgh Maulers; and the San Francisco 49ers of the National Football League (the latter owned by Edward J. DeBartolo, Jr.).

A shopping center industry leader, Mr. DeBartolo is a member of the Urban Land Institute and the National Realty Committee, and has served on the board of the International Council of Shopping Centers. Often honored for his achievements, he was in 1981 awarded an honorary Doctor of Science degree at the Florida Institute of Technology for his "contribution to the American tradition of success through hard work and personal ingenuity."

ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities—Bologna, Paris, Oxford—the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters, or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education. It is possible, also, to determine from the length of the hoods the type of degree held by the wearer—quite long for the doctor's degree, medium for the master's, short for the bachelor's.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of American colleges and universities, too, may wear regalia

which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The procession at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of **University Honors** will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
