CANDIDATE FOR THE HONORARY DEGREE DOCTOR OF LAWS

For more than half a century, **MRS. CHARLES B. CUSHWA, JR.** has devoted countless hours of personal service and given generous financial support to the young, the elderly and the handicapped, not only in her own community of Youngstown but nationally.

Mrs. Cushwa, the former Margaret E. Hall, came to Youngstown from Evanston, Illinois in 1932 following her marriage to Charles Benton Cushwa, Jr., a leading industrialist and humanitarian. Mr. Cushwa, president and board chairman of Commercial Shearing, Inc., died in 1975, and Mrs. Cushwa has carried on the family tradition of service to others which she began while a student at Saint Mary's College in Notre Dame, Indiana.

Among the organizations she has served in a leadership position are the Ohio Health and Welfare Council, Family Life Council, Ohio Commission on Aging, Mahoning County Welfare Advisory Board, Youngstown Civil Service Commission, USO National Council, Ladies of Charity, Madeleva Society and St. Elizabeth Hospital Medical Center, serving at present on its board of trustees. Mrs. Cushwa, also the Mahoning County delegate to the White House Conference on Aging in years past, has been listed in *Who's Who of American Women*.

Significant in her service has been her personal commitment to aiding others. She has spent thousands of hours in transporting the elderly and handicapped to hospitals, doctors and schools, as well as making sure that such people have an opportunity to enjoy social activities by personally driving them to many evening events.

Over the years, Mrs. Cushwa also has given financial support annually to several college students who otherwise would have been unable to attend schools of higher education. In November 1982, Mrs. Cushwa received the Youngstown Award of the Youngstown Area Chamber of Commerce in recognition of her many years of work to improve conditions in the community.

Mrs. Cushwa has also continued a long-term commitment to her alma mater, Saint Mary's College, where she graduated in 1930. In recognition of her service, she was awarded the Distinguished Alumna Medal in 1967 and an honorary Doctor of Humanities degree in 1969. In 1982, at the dedication of the Cushwa-Leighton Library, the school bestowed on her the President's Medal.

Mrs. Cushwa is an ardent supporter of Youngstown State University, as was her husband. Following his death, she continued this support and in 1979, through a generous endowment to the Youngstown State University Foundation of which she is a board member, made possible the establishment of the Charles B. Cushwa, Jr. Center for Industrial Development at YSU. In 1979, the University named in his honor Cushwa Hall, which houses the College of Applied Science and Technology and academic support units. At a banquet held in her honor on June 14, 1985, the Youngstown State University Alumni Association conferred on Mrs. Cushwa its Distinguished Citizen Award, a symbol of highest distinction given annually to a leader in the local community.

THE COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

DR. JOHN M. DUGGAN, president of Saint Mary's College in Notre Dame, Indiana, a Catholic women's college founded in 1844, will deliver the Commencement address.

A native of Connecticut, Dr. Duggan has been president of Saint Mary's since 1975. He previously served as vice president for student affairs at Vassar College, vice president of the College Entrance Examination Board, and assistant dean of freshmen at Yale University.

Dr. Duggan has also engaged in a wide variety of professional activities in the field of educa-

tion. He has been a consultant to Goucher College, the Ford Foundation, Hampshire College, and Louis Harris and Associates. He is a former trustee of the College Research Center and Bennett College and a former member of the President's Council of Fairfield University. In addition, he has served the Educational Testing Service as a member of its Committee on Tests and its Research and Development Committee.

Dr. Duggan received his bachelor's degree from College of the Holy Cross and his master's and doctoral degrees from Yale University.

ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities—Bologna, Paris, Oxford—the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters, or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education. It is possible, also, to determine from the length of the hoods the type of degree held by the wearer—quite long for the doctor's degree, medium for the master's, short for the bachelor's.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of American colleges and universities, too, may wear regalia

which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The procession at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of **University Honors** will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
