THE COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER
and
CANDIDATE FOR THE HONORARY DEGREE
DOCTOR OF LAWS

MR. JOHN J. CAFARO is well known to area residents as a generous, concerned and involved citizen. His business ventures have often brought employment — and national media attention — to the Mahoning Valley, and his less public activities in local civic organizations have contributed a great deal to their effectiveness in serving public needs.

A Youngstown native, Mr. Cafaro attended Ursuline High School and studied architecture and engineering at Youngstown State University and Kent State University. As a teenager and young adult, he worked with his father, William, and his uncle, the late John A. Cafaro, on the various shopping centers they developed. He learned from personal experience what must be done to properly plan, design, build, manage and operate shopping centers.

Mr. Cafaro is now executive vice president of The Cafaro Company, the nation's sixth largest shopping center developer and operator of more than 70 shopping centers and malls nationwide. One aspect of the shopping center industry that fascinates Mr. Cafaro is the fact that it encompasses so many diverse occupational fields: architecture, engineering, law, ecology, advertising and marketing, accounting, public relations, insurance, security, to name but a few. Mr. Cafaro also believes that the shopping center industry is an accurate barometer of the nation's economy and consumer patterns, being able to predict consumer trends long before the general public is aware of them.

In 1987, The Cafaro Company entered an entirely new field with the acquisition of the New Avanti Motor Corporation, formerly located in South Bend, Indiana. Mr. Cafaro moved the company to Youngstown, where it has provided jobs in the production of the luxury automobile. Mr. Cafaro serves as president and chief executive officer of the company.

In addition to his business pursuits, Mr. Cafaro is active in local civic and charitable organizations, including the Youngstown

Symphony Society, the Arthritis Foundation, Big Brothers and Big Sisters, among many others. He has chaired various fund raising efforts for the March of Dimes, Muscular Dystrophy, Mahoning Valley Heart Fund, and Easter Seal Society. He has received various awards, including the Outstanding Young Men of America by the United States Jaycees, and special achievement awards for The Cafaro Company's "Lifestyles" television campaign by the National Retail Merchants Association and the National Television Advertising Bureau. In addition, Mr. Cafaro has been honored for his continuing support of Mothers Against Drunk Driving and Big Brothers and Big Sisters of Mahoning Valley.

Mr. Cafaro's strong interest in government has led to his involvement in local, state and national politics. He is founder and co-chair of the Republican Team 100, a national Republican Party organization that advises and supports President George Bush. In January of this year, Mr. Cafaro, along with former Senator Barry Goldwater, received the Inner Circle award from the Republican Eagle Organization.

A longtime supporter of Youngstown State University, Mr. Cafaro and The Cafaro Company have helped make possible the University's unique curriculum in mall management, which is drawing national attention as the only baccalaureate program in the field. He has lent his expertise personally in the classroom, and indirectly by making available to students the experience and know-how of the company's top mall managers.

At a dinner held in his honor on June 16, 1989, the YSU Alumni Association conferred on Mr. Cafaro the Distinguished Citizen Award, the symbol of highest distinction given annually to a leader in the local community.

ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities — Bologna, Paris, Oxford — the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern-day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters, or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education. It is possible, also, to determine from the length of the hoods the type of degree held by the wearer—quite long for the doctor's degree, medium for the master's, short for the bachelor's.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and

administrators of American colleges and universities, too, may wear regalia which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The procession at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of University Honors will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
