**THE COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER**  
**and**  
**CANDIDATE FOR THE HONORARY DEGREE**  
**DOCTOR OF LAWS**

**C. GILBERT JAMES, JR.** is a Youngstown native who received his formal education at St. Edward's School, The Rayen School, the University of Arizona and Youngstown State University. He is currently president of James and Sons, a commercial insurance firm begun with his brother William in 1948.

After serving in the U.S. Army in World War II, Mr. James co-founded or acquired four businesses in the region: Forge Industries, Inc.; Akron Gear and Engineering Company in Akron; Bearing Distributors, Inc. in Cleveland; and Miller Spreader Company in Youngstown. Besides his continued involvement in each of those enterprises, he also sits on the boards of several local business groups, including Society Bank, the Youngstown Board of Trade, and the Youngstown Area Chamber of Commerce, where he serves as treasurer.

Known widely as a community leader and dedicated fund raiser, Mr. James has given unstintingly of his time and resources to numerous public service projects. He serves or has served on the boards of five local foundations—Rayen, International, Buechner, Swanston and Youngstown—and has been active in drives for United Way, the Butler Institute of American Art, the Alcoholic Clinic and the Mahoning County Court House restoration.

Mr. James is a trustee and past president of

the Friends of American Art of the Butler Institute of American Art, trustee of the Boys' Club, and treasurer of the Arms Museum of the Mahoning Valley Historical Society. He is vice president of the Youngstown Playhouse, trustee-advisor of the Youngstown Arts Council, and director and past president of the Canfield Fair Board.

Youngstown State University, too, has benefited from Mr. James's dedication to the public good. He served as secretary to the YSU All Sports Complex committee for the Stambaugh Stadium Fund Drive, helping to organize the highly successful campaign that helped finance the University's stadium. In 1986, he served the YSU Alumni Association as co-chair of the Distinguished Citizen Award. Mr. James also serves as a citizen advisor to the International Student Services Committee, and president of Buechner Hall.

Mr. James has, over the years, founded three museums in Youngstown: the Western Reserve Village at the Canfield Fairgrounds, the Steel Garden of the Arms Museum, and the Medical Museum at St. Elizabeth Hospital Medical Center. In 1982, he was named Man of the Year by the Youngstown Area Arts Council for his extensive work on behalf of the arts in this area. He was given the Volunteer Action Award by President Reagan in 1984 for his work with the Western Reserve Village, and was inducted into The Rayen School Hall of Fame in 1988.

## ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities — Bologna, Paris, Oxford — the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern-day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters, or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education. It is possible, also, to determine from the length of the hoods the type of degree held by the wearer—quite long for the doctor's degree, medium for the master's, short for the bachelor's.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of American colleges and

Universities, too, may wear regalia which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the masters gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The procession at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of University Honors will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
