HONORARY DOCTOR OF LAWS

Today's commencement speaker, **NATHAN H. MONUS**, is widely regarded for his business acumen and for his contributions to the community at large.

Mr. Monus is currently a board member of Giant Eagle, Inc. and Pharmor, Inc. and chairs the board of the Geordan Candy Company. He previously held positions as financial vice president of the Tamarkin Company and vice president of Giant Eagle, Inc. and Tamco Distributors, Inc.

A strong supporter of leadership development in the local area, Mr. Monus has been active in his sponsorship of Leadership Youngstown, a program designed to develop the leadership potential of community spokespersons.

Mr. Monus is also involved locally and nationally in a number of civic and religious organizations. He is president of the Joseph L. Morse Geriatric Center of Palm Beach, Florida and a national board member of the Union of American Hebrew Congregations. He has served as president of Austintown Rotary Club, Squaw Creek Country Club, Rodef Sholom Temple, the Youngstown Area

Jewish Federation and Leadership Youngstown. He has also served on the board of directors of Goodwill Industries and is a former member of the Board of Overseers of the Hebrew Union College, Jewish Institute of Religion in Cincinnati. He was named the Mahoning Valley Economic Development Corporation's Man of the Year in 1988.

A lifelong resident of Youngstown, Mr. Monus is a graduate of The Rayen School. He attended the Virginia Military Institute and The Ohio State University and, during WW II, served for four years in the European theatre.

Mr. Monus is married to the former Frances Tamarkin. They have two children, Susan B. Monus and Michael I. Monus, who is a member of the Board of Trustees of Youngstown State University. The Monuses reside in Youngstown and Palm Beach, Florida.

At a banquet in his honor on Thursday, June 20, Mr. Monus was named the YSU Alumni Association Distinguished Citizen for 1991, in appreciation for his outstanding contributions to the economic and social welfare of the region.

ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities — Bologna, Paris, Oxford — the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern-day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters, or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of American colleges and Universities, too, may wear regalia which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State

University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The procession at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of University Honors will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
