THE COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER
and
CANDIDATE FOR THE DEGREE
HONORARY DOCTOR OF LAWS

DR. VICTOR A. RICHLEY, recently retired Dean of the College of Applied Science and Technology, began his association with Youngstown State University in 1952 as an undergraduate student.

A native of Niles, Dr. Richley completed his pre-college studies in 1947. Following employment in area steel mills and military service in the Korean conflict, he attended Youngstown College on the G.I. bill. After earning a bachelor's degree in electrical engineering from Youngstown University in 1956, he was appointed to the faculty of the William Rayen School of Engineering and began his graduate studies.

While a full-service faculty member, he earned a Master of Science degree in electrical engineering at the University of Akron in 1961 and a doctorate in the same field at the University of Pittsburgh in 1967. As a member of the electrical engineering faculty, he played a significant role in initiating and directing YSU's graduate program.

He was promoted to assistant professor in 1962, in 1967 to associate professor, and in 1970 to professor. In 1969, Dr. Richley was appointed chair of the Engineering Technology Department and, in 1982, dean of the College of Applied Science and Technology.

During his tenure, he twice received the

University's highest honor for a professor, the Watson Distinguished Professor Award, in 1965 for excellence in teaching and in 1979 for excellence in administration. He was awarded NASA Summer Fellow Research Grants for 1964 and 1965, a Ford Foundation Grant in 1965, and National Science Foundation grants for 1966 and 1967. He has published in *Engineering Education* and has held regional offices in the American Society of Engineering Education.

His professional affiliations include American Society for Engineering Education, the Institute for Electrical and Electronic Engineers, and the Phi Kappa Phi Honor Society. In addition, he has served on advisory boards to the Ohio Board of Regents, St. Elizabeth Hospital Medical Center School of Nursing, and the Mahoning-Shenango Area Health Education network. He was also a member of several accreditation teams for the Technology Commission of the Accrediting Board for Engineering and Technology and the North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools.

The dean's family also has strong ties to the University. His wife, Mary, and daughter, Marilyn, are YSU alumnae, and his son James expects to graduate from the Dana School of Music this year.

ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities — Bologna, Paris, Oxford — the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern-day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters, or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of American colleges and Universities, too, may wear regalia which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State

University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The procession at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of University Honors will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
