THE COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

and

CANDIDATE FOR THE DEGREE HONORARY DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS

Today's commencement speaker, J. PHILLIP RICHLEY, is widely recognized for his more than thirty years of exemplary service to the Youngstown area, Mahoning County and the entire state of Ohio. He is currently vice president of development for the Cafaro Co. and in that capacity is responsible for the administration and management of the planning, design and financing of regional shopping centers and malls throughout the United States.

Mr. Richley is well known in the Youngstown area for his public service endeavors and his concern for economic development. In 1968, he was elected Mahoning County Engineer, and three years later, began serving as director of the Ohio Department of Transportation under Gov. John J. Gilligan. In that position, Mr. Richley oversaw the planning, design, construction and maintenance of 18,000 miles of state and federal highways in Ohio. With an annual budget of \$500,000,000, he directed 10,000 employees and administrative staff. After leaving ODOT in the mid-1970s, Mr. Richley served as a consultant with Dalton, Dalton, Little and Newport Engineering in Cleveland.

In 1978, Mr. Richley again turned his talents and attention to the local area, seeking and winning election as mayor of Youngstown. It was during his tenure as mayor, in 1979, that the collapse of the steel industry in the Mahoning Valley began with the closing of Youngstown Sheet and Tube and the layoff of over 5,000 workers. Mr. Richley's leadership was pivotal during these times, and he expressed his optimism and determination to help the local economy by founding the Mahoning Valley Economic Development Corporation, in which he has remained active.

In 1989, Mr. Richley was named MVDEC's Man of the Year.

Throughout his career, Mr. Richley has been a positive force in the development of major urban highway programs and a strong proponent of a regional mass transit system. He continues his commitment to economic development in the private sector in his work with the Cafaro Company.

Mr. Richley was born in Roccanova, Italy, and, as a small boy, settled with his family in Niles, Ohio. A 1943 graduate of Niles McKinley High School, he received his Bachelor of Engineering degree from Youngstown State University in 1954. He is an emeritus member of the board of directors of the YSU Alumni Association.

Among Mr. Richley's current affiliations, he is a member of the board of directors of the Metropolitan Savings Bank and FNB Corporation. He is also a member of the board of St. Elizabeth Hospital Medical Center. His past professional affiliations include membership in the Ohio High Speed Rail Task Force, the U.S. Chamber of Commerce Transportation Committee, the National League of Cities, and the U.S. Council of Mayors.

Mr. Richley was married to the former Josephine DiCarlo in 1948, and they have two children, Phyllis and John.

At a banquet in his honor on Thursday, June 18, Mr. Richley was named the YSU Alumni Association Distinguished Citizen for 1992, in appreciation for his outstanding record of public service and his contributions to the economic development of the region.

ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities — Bologna, Paris, Oxford — the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern-day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters, or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of American colleges and Universities, too, may wear regalia which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State

University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The procession at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of University Honors will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
