THE COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER and CANDIDATE FOR THE DEGREE HONORARY DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS

Today's commencement speaker, **James P. Appleberry**, became the second president of The American Association of State Colleges and Secondary Schools in 1991, after serving as president of Northern Michigan University for eight years. The AASCU is a Washington-based association representing 370 public institutions and thirty state systems of education. Prior to his presidency at Northern Michigan, Appleberry served for nearly seven years as president of Pittsburg State University in Kansas.

Appleberry's commitment to education is based in his belief that the nation's economic future, national security, and the education of its people are inextricably linked. "Every person in our country who grows up in ignorance because of inadequate education ultimately contributes to the decline of this nation," he has said. "The undeveloped intelligence and ability of even one person is a tragedy, as well as a tragic denial of the person's own ability to control his or her own destiny."

Appleberry has said he chose to work at the national level because AASCU is dedicated to ensuring a national commitment to low tuition levels and affordable higher education. "Any deprivation of the opportunities to learn, including the deprivation of the access to

higher education," he says, "leads to intellectual bondage."

A native of Waverly, Missouri, Appleberry began his career as a teacher and principal in a rural Missouri school district. He received his bachelor's, master's, and education specialist degrees from Central Missouri State University and was its first graduate fellow. Following completion of his doctorate at Oklahoma State University in 1968, he joined the faculty there. He holds distinguished alumni awards from both Central Missouri State and Oklahoma State.

Appleberry served as assistant, associate, and full professor, as well as chair of his academic department at Oklahoma State. In 1975 he joined the University of Kansas as director of planning and a professor of administration, foundations, and higher education. Nine months later, he was named assistant to the chancellor, a post he held until being named president at Pittsburg State University in Kansas.

Appleberry has served on numerous national committees, including the NCAA Presidents Commission. Active in AASCU since 1977, Appleberry has served as chair of the committee on research, the nominating committee, and the committee on policies and purposes.

ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities — Bologna, Paris, Oxford — the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern-day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of American colleges and universities, too, may wear regalia which is different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown

State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has a vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirements. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The recessional at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of University Honors will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
