**THE COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER
and
CANDIDATE FOR THE DEGREE
HONORARY DOCTOR OF HUMANITIES**

Today's commencement speaker, The Most Reverend James W. Malone, retired as bishop of the Diocese of Youngstown in February 1996.

A native of Youngstown, Bishop Malone earned his master's degree and a Ph.D. from Catholic University of America, Washington, D.C. Ordained as a priest in 1945 and an auxiliary bishop in 1960, he was installed as Bishop of Youngstown on June 20, 1968.

Bishop Malone served as president of the National Conference of Catholic Bishops from 1983 to 1986 and was vice president from 1980 to 1983. He has served on several major committees and boards of that group, including Ecumenical and Interreligious Affairs, Priestly Life and Ministry, the International Commission for English in the Liturgy, the Bishops' Committee on the Liturgy, and the National Advisory Council. He also served as chair of the board of the Catholic Television Network of America and co-chair of the Roman Catholic/World Methodist International Ecumenical Dialog.

On the state level, Bishop Malone served on the board of the Catholic Conference of Ohio and was past

president of the Ohio Council of Churches. Nationally, he was a member of the board of the Center for Applied Research in the Apostolate and served on the National Coalition for Health Care Ministry.

Bishop Malone's educational commitments included serving as chair of the National Catholic Educational Association and as a member of the boards of the Athenaeum of Ohio, Catholic University of America, and Walsh College.

A strong supporter of social justice and peace issues, Bishop Malone has delivered many addresses on these topics, both locally and nationally. At the local level, he has served on the boards of Commonwealth, the Labor-Management Citizens Committee, and the Northeast Ohio Employee Ownership Center.

In his retirement, Bishop Malone continues to serve as a member of the United States Catholic Conference *Ex Corde Ecclesiae* Committee. He is also a member of the Domestic Policy Committee and a consultant to the Ad Hoc Committee on Catholic Health Care, both committees of the National Conference of Catholic Bishops.

ACADEMIC REGALIA AND CEREMONY

The gowns, hoods, and caps worn in academic ceremonies today are relics of clothing worn in medieval times by students and professors. In the early universities—Bologna, Paris, Oxford—the undergraduate students had no prescribed academic dress but wore their usual clerical or ecclesiastical habits. The professors wore more colorful academic regalia than their modern-day descendants. Probably the gowns and hoods were worn for warmth in the unheated halls where the lectures were delivered. From the sixteenth century on, there is a change to somber black and it is only in the hoods worn in academic processions today that the warmth and color of medieval academic pageantry is retained.

The hoods representing degrees granted by various colleges and universities have linings (turned to exhibit their hues to the fullest advantage) in the colors of the granting institutions. In addition, the facing of the hood represents by its color the discipline in which the degree has been granted: white for arts, letters or humanities; golden yellow for science; purple for law; green for medicine; lemon yellow for library science; orange for engineering; drab for commerce or business; light blue for education; pink for music; brown for fine arts; apricot for nursing; dark blue for philosophy; scarlet for theology; citron for social work; sage green for physical education.

Since 1895, in the United States, the colors and types of caps and gowns have been largely standardized; in 1932 the code was revised to some extent, and in 1960 it was revised once more. A few American universities have adopted gowns other than black in color, and in European universities there is more diversity in cut and in the cap than prevails in the United States. Trustees and administrators of American colleges and universities, too, may wear regalia which is

different from that commonly worn. The trustees of Youngstown State University wear a specially designed cardinal gown.

The bachelor's gown is worn closed; the master's gown is worn open or closed, depending partly on its tailoring; and the wearer of the doctor's gown has the privilege of wearing it open or closed. The sleeves of the three types of gowns are of different lengths and cuts, and in addition the sleeves of the doctor's gown have three horizontal velvet stripes. The doctor's gown also has a vertical facing of velvet in front. The stripes and facing may be either black or in the color representing the field in which the wearer has received the doctorate.

There are different opinions about the origin of the caps worn in academic ceremonies. One view is that the "mortar board" is in actuality adapted from the wooden square used by masons. Another is that it stems from the ecclesiastical or clerical head covering of the medieval period. The tassels worn on the caps may or may not be of the same types. In some institutions all masters' and bachelors' tassels are black; in others the tassels, which are the same as the colors of the facings of the hoods, reflect the degree received. The tassels worn by doctors may be black or gold thread.

There is something of the same adherence to tradition in commencement processions that exists in academic garb, although each institution has the right to adapt the ceremony to its own requirement. The chief marshals lead the line of march, followed by the president, the speaker, trustees, and other members of the party to be seated on the platform. Then follow the faculty and the candidates for degrees. The recessional at the end of the ceremony follows the same order.

Recipients of University Honors will receive special insignia, consisting of golden honor cords placed around the shoulders.
